Kielce, 2-3 December 2025

We invite you to participate in the 12th edition of the international conference "Security of the Republic of Poland in the National and International Dimensions." The theme for this year's conference is: "Contemporary Security Architecture: Between Sovereignty and Interdependence." The two-day event provides a platform for interdisciplinary discussion on the most important challenges and dilemmas of contemporary security in the context of dynamic geopolitical changes. Particular emphasis will be placed on the role of Poland, Europe, and the Euro-Atlantic area in shaping the regional and global security system.

The conference aims to create an open forum for the exchange of knowledge, experiences, and research results between academics, experts, and practitioners dealing with broadly defined security. The event aims to provide an in-depth analysis of the contemporary security architecture, in which state sovereignty increasingly comes into conflict with the need for cooperation and interdependence in the face of common threats. A key element of this year's conference is a reflection on the place and role of Poland, Europe, and the entire Euro-Atlantic area in the regional and global security system. The conference also aims to inspire to search for new solutions to strengthen national and international security and to build effective mechanisms for cooperation.

The conference is aimed at: researchers, experts, doctoral candidates, and students specializing in security, international relations, law, economics, military affairs, and related fields, as well as practitioners representing public administration, the armed forces, security services, international institutions, and non-governmental organizations. Participation in the event is also open to analysts, representatives of think tanks, and anyone interested in contemporary security challenges and dilemmas at both the national and international levels.

The conference will address issues such as state sovereignty in an era of global challenges, the security of Poland and Europe in the context of changing geopolitical order, the Euro-Atlantic security architecture, the role of international organizations and alliances, as well as challenges related to cybersecurity, new technologies, disinformation, and hybrid threats. Discussions will also include local and regional state resilience and the importance of strategic culture in shaping security policies.
